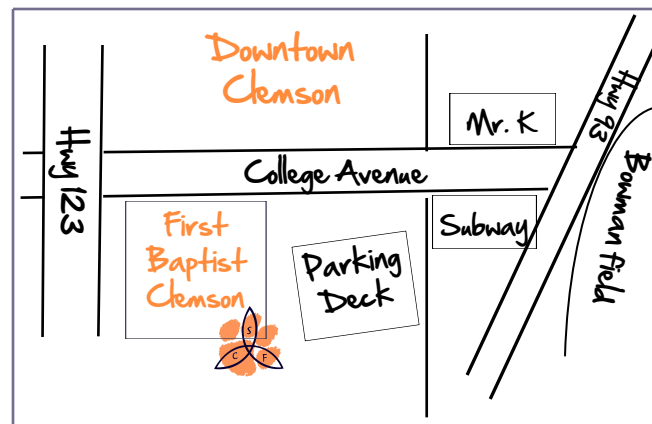

SMALL GROUPS

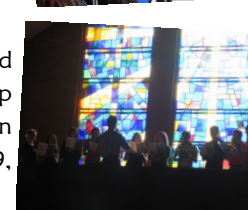
Each semester there are new small groups that meet to discuss all things life and faith. Some meet on campus or in apartments while others meet in the FBC College Lounge. The studies are led by students or the campus minister.

STUDENT LUNCHEONS

Free hot meals are offered to all students and their families following specific Sunday worship services (10:30-11:30 am). The fall luncheon dates are: August 28, September 18, October 9, November 13 and December 11.

BIBLE STUDY & BREAKFAST

College students meet Sundays at 9:30 am in the College Lounge for breakfast and in-depth study on familiar and not-so familiar parts of Scripture, led by Casey Callahan.



STUDENT ADOPTION

Student Adoption is a support system rooted in the wider family of faith. Interested students are paired with 'adoptive families' who commit to supporting the student through personal and faithful encouragement in hopes that First Baptist Clemson can feel like a 'home away from home'.

CSF COUNCIL

CSF is a student organization and is therefore primarily led by students. While all students are encouraged to become involved and help lead, the CSF Council is elected each Spring and works directly with the Campus Minister in 'big picture' planning and leadership.

COLLEGE CHORALE

College Chorale is an excellent outlet for musically-gifted students to be a part of FBC's music ministry, led by Rev. Robert Gammon (adjunct university lecturer for the Performing Arts Department). Rehearsal times and worship participation for this vocal ensemble are coordinated each new semester.

COLLEGE LOUNGE

The College Lounge is open just for students. It is located on the 2nd floor of FBC and has all things needed for students to study or relax: WIFI access, snacks, couches, tables, a printer, Direct TV & Nintendo Game Systems.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Student Membership is offered for all students who want an intentional affiliation with FBC without transferring membership from a home church. This is a great way for students to become more connected to the life and ministry of the wider church family.
